

HOW TO PUT ON A SNOWBOARD BOOT:



1. PULL OUT BOA DIAL AND OPEN TONGUE COMPLETELY



2. SLIDE UP LINER LACE-LOCK AND OPEN LINER TONGUE COMPLETELY



3. PULL UP AND OUT ON LINER TONGUE WHILE SLIDING YOUR FOOT IN (STANDING WILL HELP)

4. MAKE SURE THERE ARE NO WRINKLES IN YOUR SKI SOCKS

5. AVOID TUCKING BASE LAYERS OR PANTS INTO BOOTS

6. SECURE LINER TONGUE AGAINST SHIN

7. PULL UP ON LINER LACING HANDLE UNTIL SNUG. SLIDE DOWN AND SECURE LACE LOCK.

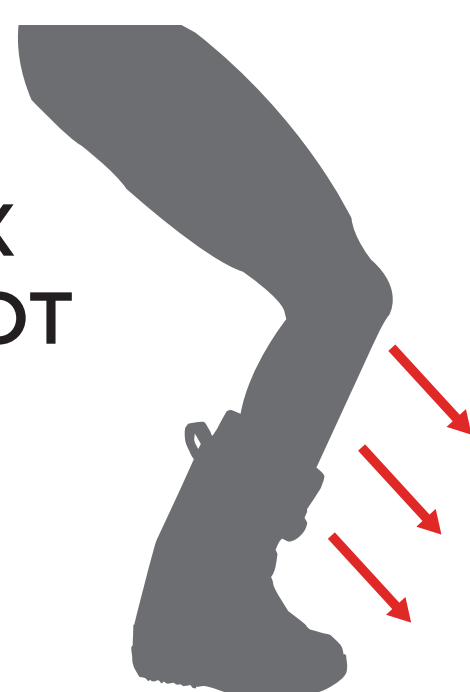


8. TUCK LINER LACING SYSTEM BEHIND BOOT TONGUE



9. PUSH IN BOA DIAL AND TURN CLOCKWISE TO GRADUALLY TIGHTEN BOOT

10. BEND AT KNEE AND FLEX FORWARD INTO THE BOOT (RIDER'S STANCE)



11. GRADUALLY ADJUST LACING SYSTEMS AS NEEDED THROUGHOUT THE DAY

BOOTS TIGHTENED TO THEIR MAX? TRY A SMALLER BOOT SIZE

CHECK FOR A GOOD FIT WHILE IN RIDER'S STANCE:

- ⌚ CAN YOU WIGGLE YOUR TOES?
- ⌚ DO YOU HAVE ZERO HEEL LIFT?
- ⌚ NO PAINFUL PRESSURE POINTS OR TINGLING?
